Rooms available to rent for meetings and events are on the fourth floor. The only fee required is the cost for room usage.
Applications can be made starting two months before the rental date on the first of that month.



[Eating & Drinking Area]

- Rest Area **1F / 4F** Food and drinks allowed. Vending machines available.

[For visitors with small children]

- Nursing Room **1F / 2F / 5F** Equipped with a nursing booth, hot water for baby formula, and a diaper changing mat (on 2F and 5F only). *Diaper changing mats are also available in multipurpose restrooms on each floor.
- Children's Restroom **2F**
- Kids' Rest Area (inside Kids' Space) **5F** An area for small children where food and drinks are allowed.
- Forward-Facing Baby Stroller Rental **1F / 2F / 5F**
- Parent-Facing Baby Stroller Rental **2F / 3F / 5F** Parent-Facing Baby Strollers can hold a basket and your belongings.

[For the disabled]

- Multipurpose Restrooms **Every Floor** Restrooms on 1F, 2F, and 4F are equipped with facilities for ostomates. Restrooms on 1F, 3F, and 5F are equipped with a multipurpose bed.
- Speech Transliteration Rooms: **1F / 2F / 3F (6 rooms)** A room where volunteers read out books and materials for those who require assistance. The user must register for "Services for The Visually Impaired and Others in Need of Assistance". Reservation is also required.
- Audio Induction Loop System A device that converts the sounds picked up by the microphone into signals that can be received by hearing aids. It is installed at the General Information Counter (1F), Hall (4F), Planetarium (5F), and the information desk on each floor. Switch your hearing aid / artificial inner ear to the "T mode" to use it.
- Rollator Rental: **1F / 2F / 3F** ●Wheelchair Rental: **1F / 2F / 4F / 5F**
- Assistance Dog Toilet (**1F, South side of the South Entrance**)

[Various Library Areas]

- There are various areas for different usage styles. For those who have brought in their own study materials, please use the Study Room (4F).
- Common Learning Space (Learning Commons) **2F** Area to discuss and exchange knowledge with books and magazines borrowed from the library. Snacks are allowed.
 - Group Room **2F / 3F (5 rooms)** Rooms where groups of people can hold discussions using library materials. Each room has a different capacity (6/8/10 people). Registration with the library is required. Reservation is required. **[Reservation Method]** Reservation on the day of use: Through the Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) located within the library or at the Library Counter / Reservation in advance: Through the library website
 - Private Study Room **3F (9 rooms)** Rooms to study and take notes from the library materials. Only one person per room is allowed. Registration with the library is required. **[Reservation Method]** Reservation on the day of use: Through the Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) located within the library or at the Library Counter / Reservation in advance: Through the library website
 - Audiovisual Booth **3F (7 booths)** Booths where one can watch DVDs owned by the library. Capacity: 1 to 4 people. Can be used for the duration of the audiovisual material + 10 minutes before and after watching the video. Available once a day. Registration with the library is required. Reservation can only be made on the day of use. **[Reservation Method]** Bring one audiovisual material to the ⑦ Audiovisual Counter
